



#IAmJuliana June 1 Call to Action

Since 2015, 21 young people from across the country have been suing the federal government for violating their constitutional rights to life, liberty, and property by knowingly contributing to climate change for over five decades. Like *Brown v. Board of Education* did for civil rights, *Juliana* has the **potential to become the landmark climate change case of our country's history**.

For nearly four years the government has done everything it can to prevent the case from going to trial—and has watched the District Court, the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals, and the U.S. Supreme Court reject their attempts to dismiss the case. The upcoming June 4 hearing before the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals in Portland, Oregon is a **critical turning point in the case**: in addition to deciding whether the case will finally go to trial, this hearing **will decide whether or not to cease creation of new federally-approved fossil fuel infrastructure** in the U.S. while the appeal is being heard. That's huge.

At this important moment in the evolution of both this court case and the youth climate movement, [Future Coalition](#), the largest network of youth-led organizations in the U.S., and [Our Children's Trust](#), the organization behind the *Juliana v. U.S.* case, are joining forces to bring widespread attention and name recognition to the case and to the constitutional rights the young plaintiffs seek to protect.

We've srieked, marched, and rallied. Now, it's time to spread our message even wider. People need to hear us and understand that young people will not sit by as our world is destroyed around us.

The Youth Climate Movement is growing, and *Juliana* is a natural next stage of it. This is a history-making case, and all young people should have a chance to make history. This is our time as a generation to come together and stand up for ourselves and all the kids to come after us.
